What's the plan?

12 month campaign (May 17 – Jun 18)

Activities:

- recruiting Food Saver Champions to spread the word about reducing food waste
- inviting 15 families to take part in the Zero Waste Kitchen Challenge
- installing three community fridges, where people can donate their leftovers to be used by others
- distributing 'Waste less, Save more' welcome packs to Durham University students
- promoting the free food sharing app: Olio
- organising three 'Feed the 1,000' events to give away meals using food that would otherwise have been thrown away
